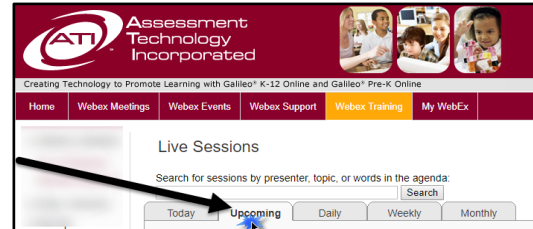

### Differentiating Instruction for Students based on Risk Level Report

Wednesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>

**Time:** 4:00-5:00 pm EDT / 1:00-2:00 pm MST

**Audience:** Teachers and support staff responsible for instructional interventions and progress monitoring.

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and interpreting assessment results from the *Risk Level Summary* and the *Instruction Performance Tracker* reports. The data from these reports support group instruction designed to raise the developmental levels of all students in the group. Participants learn how to use Galileo’s *Quiz Builder* and *Instructional Dialog* tools to reteach selected standards or reassess subsequent instruction.

### Getting Ready for Parent-Teacher Conferences

**Time:** 4:00-5:00 pm EDT / 1:00-2:00 pm MST

**Audience:** Teachers and support staff responsible for managing student information in the *K-12 Student-Parent Center*.

**Description:** This session walks participants through generating and interpreting the *Individual Development Profile* and the *Student Multi-Test* reports. Participants will also learn how parents access and navigate the *K-12 Student-Parent Center* and access the student’s assessment results..

### Interpreting Item Analysis Data

Thursday, November 1<sup>st</sup>

**Time:** 4:00-5:00 pm EDT / 1:00-2:00 pm MST

**Audience:** Educators interested in analysis of student performance on an assessment by standard and item.

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and interpreting the *Item Analysis Report* views.

### Utilizing the K-12 Student-Parent Center

**Audience:** Administrators and Teachers

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and navigating around the *K-12 Student-Parent Center*. The session explores how students access assessments and *Instructional Dialogs* through the interface. Additionally, users are introduced to the center's features such as the Launchpad tiles, calendar view, Google Translate, and parent reports.

### Differentiating Instruction for Students based on data from the Intervention Alert Report

**Audience:** Teachers and specialists responsible for instructional interventions and progress monitoring.

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and interpreting the Intervention Alert report, which details how each student performed on each standard recently assessed. For students needing additional assistance, this report provides access to follow-up instruction and re-assessment. Participants learn how to use the Quiz Builder and the Assignments tools to reteach a standard or reassess subsequent instruction for targeted students.

### Development Profile Reports

**Audience:** Teachers, curriculum coaches, instructional designers, and educators responsible for interpreting assessments.

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and interpreting the *Development Profile* report and the parent-friendly *Individual Development Profile* report. These reports can help educators monitor the effectiveness of initial standards-based instruction as well as the effectiveness of reteaching.

### Exploring the Benchmark Performance Levels Widget

**Audience:** Teachers and specialists responsible for instructional interventions and progress monitoring.

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and interpreting data on the *Benchmark Performance Levels* widget. The *Benchmark Performance Levels* report can be found on the Teacher Dashboard. This widget presents summary data as well individual student data that help teachers inform instruction and monitor student progress throughout the year.

### Test Monitoring

**Audience:** Teachers and Test Administrators responsible for monitoring students during online test administration.

**Description:** This session walks participants through accessing and interpreting the *Test Monitoring* report during and after testing. Participants will also learn how to view and enter test scores.
